Athabasca University Mace

Created by Brian Clark, originally from the Fort McMurray region of Alberta, the Athabasca University Mace is symbolic of the traditional talking stick commonly used by many indigenous people to express the authority and power of the group. The component parts of the mace were selected based on the artist's perception of the wildlife that Alberta Native People regard as being most powerful and worthy of respect:

- The base is moose horn, chosen because of the way the moose feeds low for strength yet stands tall and strong in its domain.
- The shaft is pine and fir, fully twisted, challenging all directions at once.
- The bear claws reflect the balance of power by the strongest in nature.
- The bear teeth represent wisdom and solidarity.
- The arrowhead represents firmness and counsel.
- The stone eagle's head represents guidance and spirit.
- The eagle and raven feathers represent mobility and wariness.
- The beads represent the human element, so lightly attached to nature.



History of Athabasca University

Athabasca University was established by Order in Council of the Government of Alberta on June 25, 1970. Originally conceived as a traditional campus-based institution, AU changed course in 1972 through a pilot project to test the concept of an open, distance university. The first AU course, World Ecology, was offered in 1973, and AU's first Convocation, for two graduates, was held in 1977. The university achieved self-governing status as Alberta's fourth public university on April 12, 1978.

By 1984, AU had outgrown its original facilities in Edmonton and, in accordance with the policy of decentralization favoured by the provincial government of the day, the university moved 145 kilometres north to the Town of Athabasca. Satellite campuses were established in Calgary, Edmonton and Fort McMurray, Alberta, to enable students to receive first-hand educational support services and to write invigilated examinations. The Fort McMurray location closed in 2000.

During the 1980s, in keeping with its mandate to explore new ways of delivering post-secondary education to students anywhere, any time, AU pioneered the use of computers to deliver online courses. AU's executive MBA program, the world's first online EMBA, was introduced by the Centre for Innovation Management in 1994.

Today, AU is one of the world's foremost online and distance education institutions.



Athabasca University at a Glance

Athabasca University provides learning for life. Through the achievements of its students, faculty and staff, AU stands out as a provider of high quality post-secondary education.

As of March 31, 2010, AU

- served 38,190 students (7,701 full-load equivalents)
- offered 838 courses in 49 undergraduate and graduate degree, diploma and certificate programs in a range of arts, science and professional disciplines
- had an operating budget of over \$125 million
- employed 1,447 faculty and staff members (full-time equivalents) in Athabasca, St. Albert, Edmonton and Calgary
- maintained over 350 collaborative agreements with other Canadian and international post-secondary institutions, with professional associations and employer groups and with First Nations institutions and communities

AU students come from every Canadian province and territory and 90 countries worldwide.

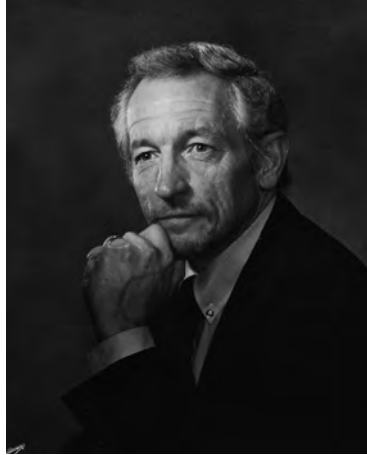
- The average undergraduate is 29; the average graduate student, 36.
- 81 per cent work while they study.
- 67 per cent are women.
- Over 90 per cent study year round, balancing their studies with work, family or community commitments.
- 63 per cent of graduates support dependents.
- 74 per cent of graduates are the first in their family to earn a university degree.

Many students enrolled at other post-secondary institutions make extensive use of AU courses and educational services to help them complete their degrees. These visiting students take AU courses for transfer to an academic program at their home institution. Still others take AU courses out of personal interest or for professional development.

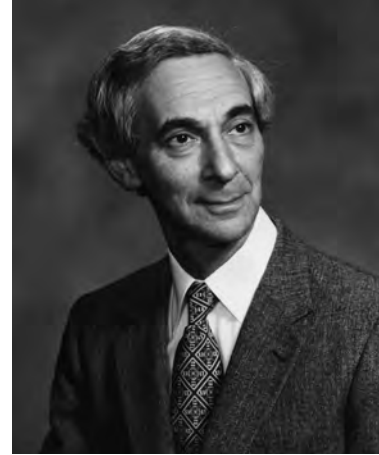

Academic Regalia

Formal academic dress dates from medieval times and consists of a robe, a hood and sometimes a distinctive hat. Today, the hood, which was once worn to protect the scholar's head and shoulders in inclement weather, is worn down the back and is kept in place by a neckband that rests on the shoulders. The degree which an AU graduate holds is indicated by the colour of the lining or trim on his or her hood.
